4. Dog Park - Citizens wanted to thank the City for the dog park, the group had some concerns on some piping in the NW corner of the park.
 - a. Bill will have engineering look at it and come up with some recommendations
5. Parks and Facilities Maintenance Update
 - a. Report on Parks and Recreation facilities & projects – city wide, May – July 2025, and report on upcoming activities.
 - b. Show Low Lake Group Camp restroom complete
 - c. Splash Pad opened May 1. Temporarily closed due to pump controls issue.
 - d. Installation of turf at Williams family field is complete.
 - e. McKay Park – waiting for grant
 - f. Woody’s property parking is under construction. Should be open in 6 weeks or so.
 - g. The City Campus Recreation Building is under constructure, Framing, rough plumbing are done. Electrical will be done in 2 weeks. Then drywall. Schedule for completion Mid-October
 - h. The City was approached by a group called Union Sportsman’s Alliance. They are interested in providing volunteers and materials to construct a Pavilion similar the ones at Fool’s Hollow at the Show Low Lake Group Camping area. Have permitted plans and meeting with volunteers August 20.
 - i. New playground equipment ordered for Ponderosa field and s/l/ Lake
 - j. Sports and event center design build phase 1 contractor has been approved by council. Getting contracts signed.
 - k. Aquatic Center will be closed for annual maintenance early this year. Pool needs to be re-plastered.
 - l. BMX had a successful State Race that brough in nearly 500 racers.
 - m. Will be doing landscaping at City Campus, including artificial turf between pickleball courts.

- n. Reidhead house adobe repair scheduled to start late August – Early September. They are currently making the adobe bricks.

 - a.  - b. Aquatic center, 400+ swimmer for swim lessons, 50 swim team participants, hosted a swim meet, Guys night out had 175 guys, Tie Die Tuesday sold out each event, Snack Shack opened and is doing great. Splash Pad is open and busy through October.
 - c. Mike reported that 6 new workout stations will be added around the trail adding to the existing stations. Working on adding Flag Football.
